The owner and manager of his law firm, Philip J. Chanfrau graduated from Stetson College with both a BS and a JD degree with honors in 1970. He began his practice in Daytona in 1970. In 1977 WM Chanfrau and Phil formed a partnership known as Chanfrau & Chanfrau where he remained in practice until 2002. In 2009, he moved his practice to Palm Coast, Florida. Mr. Chanfrau does exclusively Plaintiff's litigation and handles malicious prosecution, motor vehicle, slip and fall, medical malpractice, insurance disputes, dog bite, nursing home cases and probate litigation.

During a recent trial in Tampa, Phil won a \$1.3 million dollar verdict against a trucking company in a CRPS- RSD (reflex sympathetic dystrophy) case.
